Practical details

How to reach Bratislava and the hotel Saffron

From the Vienna airport take the bus to Bratislava in front of the arrival hall, get off the bus at the Bratislava Central Bus Station (cca 45 minutes).

From the **Central Bus Station**, there are more possibilities:

1. the trolley No 206 (direction to Kramáre) – 2 stops to the Špitálska, then walk to the Mariánska street, take the tram No 3 and the 2nd stop is the Blumental
2. the trolley No 210 (direction Hlavná stanica, Main railway station) - 4 stops to Račianske múto, walk to the tram stop No.5 (direction Dúbravka), 1 stop to the Blumental

Taxi

The price is: approximately about 7-10 € from the main bus station. Ask the Taxi driver about the price before you get in

From the **Bratislava airport** is the best is to take a taxi. There is also a bus No 61 /direction Railway station/ - 15 stops to the Račianske múto, then walk to the tram stop No 5 or No 3, 1 stop to the Blumental church

From the **Central Railway Station** take the tram No 2, take off at the third stop Blumental .

Local transport tickets buy in a kiosk or a vendor machine at the bus stop.
